This has been a long start to the Tippecanoe 4H Shootings Sports year and we want to apologize for how long this has taken to get together. We would like to invite you out for your disciplines on the following schedules for the first date meeting:

- Shotgun, Pistol and Air Rifle
  - April 6<sup>th</sup>: 6pm – 9pm @ Linden Conservation Club
- Archery
  - April 14<sup>th</sup>: 6:30pm – 9pm @ Linden Conservation Club
- First Year Students
  - April 10<sup>th</sup>: 8am – Noon @ Linden Conservation Club
- .22 Rifle
  - April 24<sup>th</sup>: 8am – 11am @ Wildcat Valley Rifle & Pistol Club

We will have some additional rules to follow for our COVID safety plan.

- We can have 1 adult from each family/discipline.
  - If you have 1 or more students in a single discipline, then we can have a single adult there.
    - E.g.: 2 students in Pistol, please only have 1 adult present.
  - If you have 2 or more students in multiple disciplines at the same time, you may have 1 adult per discipline.
    - E.g.: 1 student in pistol and 1 student in shotgun, you may have 1 adult observing each student
- Please ensure that all students and adults present have a mask and hand sanitizer.
- Please follow the 6 ft. per person social distancing guidelines.
- If your student shows any symptoms of COVID, please refrain from having them attend until the symptoms are alleviated.
- Please sign into the attendance sheets for each discipline attended so that students may receive the credit due them and for contact tracing in the event there is a COVID exposure.
- If a student is not using their own equipment, they will be asked to wipe down the shared equipment between each use.
- Please refrain from bringing food/drink not only due to the potential to spread illness but also due to the nature of shooting sports, there is the potential for lead exposure with the lead-based ammunition that is utilized for these events.
  - Prior to any consumption of food or beverages, it is highly recommended that the participants wash their hands with soap and warm water for a minimum of 1-2 minutes.
